Bishop wrote The History of Cornell, which was once required reading for all entering Cornell freshman. Bishop also brought his friend, Vladimir Nabokov, to Cornell in 1948. (Yes, Nabokov really slept and wrote here.) Bishop's wife Alison Mason Kingsbury was noted for her murals and landscapes. Her art studio was the Great Room! One of the bathrooms features a mural painted by Kingsbury. The house has a very calming, creative feel, and all of the women who have lived here have been artists.
